TOKYO, January 27, 2011—Hitachi Maxell, Ltd. (hereafter "Maxell") today announced that the establishment of a new company was approved at the Board of Directors Meeting held January 27, 2011. The new company, to be named Hitachi Maxell Energy, Ltd. (hereafter "Maxell Energy"), will be established through a corporate spin-off on April 1, 2011. Maxell Energy will conduct manufacturing and sales activities as part of Maxell's battery operations.

1. Background and Purpose of the Spin-off

Maxell works to develop its business in batteries, which are key devices for its "Social Innovation Business." Maxell also concentrates on other businesses, such as the functional materials, optical components, information storage media, and brand businesses that form basis Maxell businesses. By advancing a business structure that is based on these two operational pillars, Maxell aims to maximize revenues. After the spin-off, the newly established Maxell Energy will take over the Company's battery manufacturing and sales operations. This will serve to expedite decision-making processes and subsequently improve revenues.
