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Hitachi and CCI Paris Ile-de-France & CEFJ host EU Hitachi Science and Technology Forum to inspire the healthcare systems of the future

London, UK, October 13 2014 – Hitachi Europe Ltd., a wholly owned subsidiary of Hitachi Ltd. (TSE: 6501, "Hitachi") and Paris Ile-de-France Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCI Paris Ile-de-France) & the Comité d'Echanges Franco-Japonais (CEFJ) today announced that they will host the EU Hitachi Science and Technology Forum at the CCI Paris Ile-de-France on 17th October. This year's Forum will focus on driving innovative collaborations for better healthcare, and members from the Ministry of Health will be in attendance.

Hitachi has hosted the EU Hitachi Science & Technology Forum biennially since 1998, to assess and debate the impact of new technologies on European society. The most recent forum was held in the UK in 2012 and addressed transport and mobility. Other topics have included the impact of Europe's ageing society and the opportunities of sustainable energy.

At this year's forum, there will be a number of collaborative sessions addressing the current state of healthcare provision and predictions for the future, including the problems facing the healthcare sector across the globe and how individual countries are tackling universal issues, such as ageing populations and chronic diseases. Discussions will also cover the profound impact of genomics, telecommunications and Big Data analysis to enable personalisation of care, as well as understanding how technology and collaborative initiatives could help to create new and innovative solutions.

Healthcare forms a key pillar of the global rollout of Hitachi's Social Innovation Business as part of its 2015 Mid-term Management Plan. In the UK, Hitachi established the European Big Data Research Laboratory with the focus of health care in June 2013, and has started Proof of Concept projects for the use of informatics to improve healthcare with the National Health Service (NHS) England (Greater Manchester). Furthermore, in July 2014, Hitachi announced a roll-out of mobile Wi-Fi scanners in Turkish hospitals to offer convenient mobile identification for the patient at the point of care.
