The Commission's vision for **low emission mobility**

The **European Strategy for Low-Emission Mobility** adopted by the Commission on 20 July 2016 aims at ensuring that Europe stays competitive and able to respond to the increasing mobility needs of people and goods, while meeting the challenges of climate change.



Increase the **efficiency of the transport system** by making the most of digital technologies, smart pricing and further encouraging the shift to lower emission transport modes



Speed up the deployment of **low-emission alternative energy** for transport, such as advanced biofuels, renewable electricity and renewable synthetic fuels and removing obstacles to the electrification of transport



Move and accelerate the **transition towards zero-emission vehicles** (while continuing to improve the internal combustion engines).
